

How do I read my ebook? Tips from PixyJack Press

Before you download an ebook, install a free ebook reading app on your computer, tablet, or smartphone. Find these apps on their websites, Google Play or iTunes App Store. We suggest:

- **Kindle app** or **Adobe Digital Editions** for computers/laptops, Android devices
- **iBooks app** or **Kindle app** for Apple devices (iPad, iPhone, etc)

Direct Download & Read

1. **From your device / computer where you want to read the ebook**, find the PixyJack Press email that says: “Files ready to download.”
2. Choose “epub” if you installed iBooks or Adobe Digital Editions, or “mobi” for a Kindle app.
3. Wait for book to fully download (may take a few minutes).
4. **Select “Open With” or “Open in” option** (the reading app should be listed next to it).
5. Click “OK” or click that link to open the book.

Note: You may need to save the book to your reading app’s library.

Side-Loading (Save & Transfer)

1. From your computer, find the PixyJack Press email that says: “Files ready to download.”
2. Choose “epub” if you installed iBooks or Adobe Digital Editions, or “mobi” for a Kindle app.
3. Wait for book to fully download (may take a few minutes).
4. **Select the “Save File” option** to save the file to your hard-drive.

Transfer to Kindles:

5. Email the “mobi” file to your Send-To-Kindle email address.
Find this email address on your Kindle (Settings > Device options > Personalize your Kindle); or log into your amazon account and look under “Manage Your Content and Devices.”
6. **OR** Attach your Kindle (do not turn on your Kindle) to your computer via a USB cable. Place the “mobi” file in the “Documents” folder on your Kindle.
Note: The ebook will appear under “All Items” on that device (not the Cloud).

Transfer to Apple devices:

5. Open iTunes on your computer and select the BOOKS library (“My Books”).
6. Drag & drop the “epub” file to the Books library, or choose File > Add to Library.
7. Then attach and sync your mobile Apple device (or “add” the book to it).
8. Open the iBooks app to begin reading.

Transfer to Android devices, Nook, Kobo:

5. Attach your device to your computer via a USB cable (it will be recognized as a separate hard-drive). Open the file manager to show the device’s folders.
6. If you installed Adobe Digital Editions, put the “epub” file in “Digital Editions” folder. If you installed the Kindle app, put the “mobi” file in the “Kindle” folder of that device.
7. Open the reading app to get started.
8. For Nook readers, put the “epub” file in the “My Documents” folder of your Nook.
9. For Kobo devices: please visit: www.kobo.com/desktop for instructions.
